INCENTIVE/REWARD FOR MAKING SOTL WORK PUBLIC BEYOND ISU

At Illinois State University, the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) is defined as "*the systematic study/reflection on teaching and learning [of our ISU students] made public.*"

The Cross Chair in the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning is offering \$200 'incentives/rewards'--while funds last-- to ISU faculty and staff who submit a product representing their ISU SoTL work (as defined above) to a book, journal, newsletter, conference, website, blog, juried show, or similar external and peer reviewed/judged outlet. Only one \$200 incentive will be awarded per submission.

To earn this incentive/reward, the following requirements must be met and clearly documented:

- 1. The product (e.g., paper, presentation, video creative product...) must clearly be a representation or summary of a SoTL project as defined above.
- 2. The product must be submitted between January 1 and April 25, 2016.
- 3. The outlet to which the product is submitted must be external to ISU and involve peer or editorial review, judging, or a similar form of scholarly review.

To apply, send the following by April 25 (funding is limited so applications are best done as soon as submission has occurred) to <u>sotl@ilstu.edu</u> as a pdf file(s) and/or in body of email:

- 1. A clear summary of the SoTL project (research question/focus, context, who was 'studied', method or type/source of 'data', main results...). (1 pg. max.)
- 2. An official acknowledgment (e.g., letter, email) from the author, editor, blog editor, conference organizer, etc. of the outlet that clearly indicates what you submitted and when.
- 3. Official documentation (letter from editor, copy of information from a web page, etc.) that shows the outlet has some form of scholarly review.
