

SCHOLARSHIP OF TEACHING AND LEARNING IDEA/PROJECT BRAINSTORMING SESSION



At Illinois State University, the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) is defined as “the systematic study/reflection on teaching and learning [of our ISU students] made public.” Similar definitions are used on many other campuses.

- Have an early, vague idea for a possible SoTL project
- Have a ‘definite’ SoTL project idea/question you want to study

- Have a SoTL project in progress
